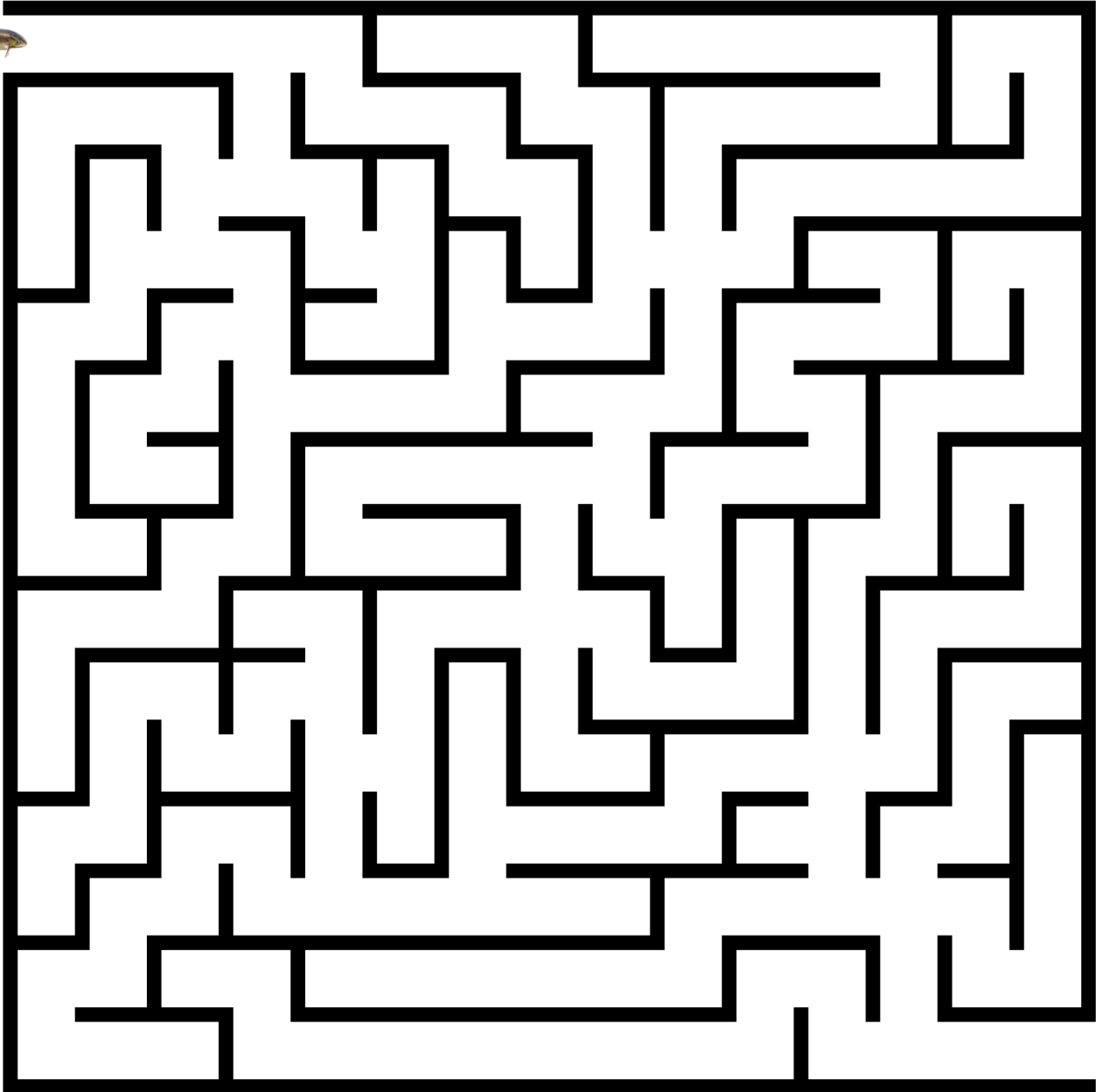


SAVE THE SALMON!

Fishy Facts

- After venturing back from the North Sea, Atlantic Salmon return to the same river they were born in - finding it by smell!
- Approximately 9 in 10 Atlantic Salmon die after spawning.
- Did you know, the highest recorded salmon jump is over 3.5 metres! That's over a metre more than the highest ever human jump! Even though salmon can jump a long way, sometimes dams and weirs (like the dead ends in the maze above) can stop them from finding the best places to lay their eggs upstream.
